BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated to Montana state university from the general fund the following amounts:

- (a) for fiscal year 1990, \$107,983; and
- (b) for fiscal year 1991, \$183,071.
- 15 (2) The appropriations in subsection (1) must be used
  16 to offer sophomore level nursing courses on extended
  17 campuses in Missoula, Billings, and Great Falls on a summer
  18 rotation basis in order to accommodate students who desire
  19 to pursue nursing careers but who are unable to move to
  20 Bozeman to fulfill their nursing curriculum requirements.
  - (3) The legislature recognizes that this appropriation will require a base adjustment and that the summer rotation basis for the three municipalities will require increased support in the third year of operation.
