 2 INTRODUCED BY Hand
 3
 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO PROVIDE SUPPORTED
 5 LIVING AND HABILITATION SERVICES TO ADULTS WHO ARE
 6 DEVELOPMENTALLY DISABLED; APPROPRIATING FUNDS; AND PROVIDING
 7 AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

8
 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
 10 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Supported living and
 11 habilitation services for the developmentally disabled. (1)
 12 The department of social and rehabilitation services shall
 13 provide supported living and habilitation services to adults
 14 who are developmentally disabled and who are in need of
 15 services in order to live and function independently.

16 (2) Services under subsection (1) may include
 17 prevocational services, sheltered employment, supported
 18 work, personal care, specialized living arrangements, and
 19 other home or community-based services that enhance the
 20 ability of adults who are developmentally disabled to live
 21 and function independently.

22 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Federal medicaid waiver. The
 23 department of social and rehabilitation services shall seek
 24 a waiver of federal medicaid requirements in accordance with
 25 42 CFR, part 441, subpart G, to provide supported living and

1 habilitation services as required under [this act].

2 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Appropriation. (1) The
 3 following money is appropriated to the department of social
 4 and rehabilitation services to provide supported living and
 5 habilitation services as required under [this act]:

11 (2) The appropriation contained in subsection (1)
 12 includes funds to pay for supported living and habilitation
 13 services for at least eight eligible adults in each fiscal
 14 year, four of whom must be persons who require intensive
 15 services.

16 NEW SECTION. Section 4. Extension of authority. Any
 17 existing authority to make rules on the subject of the
 18 provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of
 19 [this act].

20 NEW SECTION. Section 5. Effective date. [This act] is
 21 effective July 1, 1989.

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
