10 *53-5101. Functions of department of family services.

11 The department of family services shall:

12 (1) consult with and advise organized--efforts--by
13 communities, organizations, associations, and groups that
14 are working toward--any--forms--of--assistance to assist
15 individuals with the problems of aging;

16 (2) study and identify problems of aging;

17 (3) review existing programs for the aging and make
18 recommendations to the governor and the legislature for
19 improvements in such programs;

20 (4) encourage the sponsorship of community projects
21 which will seek to make optimum use of the time and talents
22 of retired persons;

23 (5) coordinate, through area councils on aging, the
24 delivery of ~~community-based-care~~ in-home services for the
25 aging, including but not limited to ~~home--health-care~~

1 homemaker and home chore services, foster--home---care,
2 nutrition, home-delivered meals, home health aide services,
3 health screening, personal care, physical therapy, respite
4 care, skilled in-home nursing service, medical
5 transportation, winterization, information and referral, and
6 recreation."

7 NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Appropriation. (1) There is
8 appropriated from the general fund to the department of
9 family services for the biennium ending June 30, 1991, the
10 sum of \$500,000 to provide additional in-home services for
11 the aging under 53-5-101.

12 (2) The appropriation in subsection (1) is an increase
13 in funding above the funding level for fiscal year 1989 for
14 in-home services for the aging.

15 NEW SECTION. **Section 3.** Extension of authority. Any
16 existing authority to make rules on the subject of the
17 provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of
18 [this act].

19 NEW SECTION. **Section 4.** Effective date. [This act] is
20 effective July 1, 1989.
