Dear Representative Vincent and Senator Galt:

In accordance with the power vested in me as Governor by the Constitution and laws of the State of Montana, I hereby make the following line-item veto to House Bill 768, "AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE MONEY FROM THE GENERAL FUND TO MONTANA STATE UNIVERSITY TO SUPPORT STAFF AND OPERATIONS FOR THE EXPANDED FACILITIES OF THE MUSEUM OF THE ROCKIES."

House Bill 768 appropriates \$531,241 of additional tax dollars to Montana State University to support on-going staff and operation expenses for the Museum of the Rockies. The Museum demonstrates an excellent means of promoting Montana tourism and preserving her rich history. The capable and fine staff of the Museum and the private individuals and entities that support the Museum are fine examples of private and public sector partnership.

However, the appropriation of House Bill 768 creates an ongoing reliance on public sector funding, growth in government funding and increases taxpayer burdens. Our state and our people are not in a position financially to afford continued on-going new programs.

Numerous worthy programs have been reviewed and turned down by the legislature and this Governor. I am, however, convinced that a one year appropriation for staff operation of this unique tourist promotion facility demonstrates a compelling public policy interest to permit a one-time start-up funding. I am convinced that the monies spent on this project remaining after my line-item veto will significantly boost state tourism and the state and local economies.

Therefore, I line-item veto the appropriation amount found in Section 1 of House Bill No. 768, (Enrolled Copy) for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 1990, in the amount of \$269,040. I approve the remaining portions of the bill. I append to the bill, at the time of my signing, this statement of the item I have line-item vetoed and my objectives thereto.
