 4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE

5 DEPARTMENT DESIGNATED BY THE GOVERNOR TO ADMINISTER THE
 6 FEDERAL SURPLUS PROPERTY PROGRAM TO RECEIVE A LOAN FROM THE
 7 PROPRIETARY FUND; PROVIDING FOR REPAYMENT OF THE LOAN;
 8 PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
 9 DATE."

 11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Loan authorization --
 13 repayment. (1) The department designated by the governor,
 14 pursuant to 18-5-201, to administer federal surplus property
 15 may receive during fiscal year 1990 a loan of \$150,000 from
 16 the general fund for the purpose of administering the
 17 federal surplus property program.

18 (2) The loan authorized in subsection (1) must be
 19 repaid in five annual installments of \$30,000 plus interest
 20 at 10% per year beginning in fiscal year 1990.

21 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Appropriation. There is
 22 appropriated from the proprietary fund \$250,000 in fiscal
 23 year 1990 and \$250,000 in fiscal year 1991 to the department
 24 designated by the governor under 18-5-201 to administer the
 25 federal surplus property program.

1 NEW SECTION. Section 3. Extension of authority. Any
 2 existing authority to make rules on the subject of the
 3 provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of
 4 [this act].

5 NEW SECTION. Section 4. Codification instruction.
 6 [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part
 7 of Title 18, chapter 5, part 2, and the provisions of Title
 8 18, chapter 5, part 2, apply to [section 1].

9 NEW SECTION. Section 5. Coordination. If House Bill
 10 No. 691, including amendments to 18-5-201 authorizing the
 11 governor to designate a department to administer the federal
 12 surplus property program, is not passed and approved, [this
 13 act] is void.

14 NEW SECTION. Section 6. Effective date. [This act] is
 15 effective July 1, 1989.
