A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED:, "AN ACT APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR

SALARY INCREASES FOR CERTIFIED AND LICENSED FACULTY OF THE

FEFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriation. (1) There is appropriated \$150,000 for each year of the biennium ending June 30, 1991, from the general fund to the board of public education for increasing salaries for each year of the biennium for certified and licensed faculty of the Montana school for the deaf and blind.

(2) The funds appropriated in subsection (1) must be used to work towards pay equity between certified and licensed faculty of the Montana school for the deaf and blind and teachers employed by Montana public school districts. The amount of the salary increases must be determined through collective bargaining.

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date. [This act] is effective July 1, 1989.
