INTRODUCED BY MALE COMMISSIONER OF HIGHER EDUCATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING MATCHING FUNDS TO THE UNIVERSITY SYSTEM FOR SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Appropriation for research program. There is appropriated \$1.5 million from the general fund to the commissioner of higher education for a university system research program. The money must be allocated to the various university unit research programs qualifying under this section. The money may be used only to provide matching funds for research proposals successfully funded by the experimental program for stimulating competitive research (EPSCOR) administered by the national science foundation. The matching fund ratio may not exceed \$1 of state money for every \$2 of national science foundation support. Any unallocated portion of the appropriation reverts to the general fund.
