NEW SECTION. Section 1. Short title. [Sections 1 through 7] may be cited as the "Montana Collegiate License Plates Act".

NEW SECTION. Section 2. Definition. As used in [sections 1 through 7], the following definitions apply:
(1) "Collegiate license plates" means license plates bearing the colors, numerals, letters, and insignia provided in [section 3] and issued as provided in [sections 4 through $6]$.
(2) "Institution" means:
(a) a unit of the montana university system as designated in 20-25-201; or
(b) a college or university located in Montana and
accredited by a national or regional accrediting association for institutions of higher learning to grant baccalaureate degrees.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Collegiate license plates. (1) Subject to the provisions of 61-3-332(3) and the requirement that collegiate license plates must have a white reflectorized background, the department shali design, cause to be manufactured, and issue collegiate license plates as provided in [sections 4 through 6].
(2) After consultation with each institution, the department shall prescribe the color and insignia to be displayed on the collegiate license plates for each institution.
(3) In addition to each institution's distinctive color and insignia provided in subsection (1), each collegiate 1 icense plate must:
(a) be imprinted consecutively with distinctive numerals from 1 through 99999, capital letters A through $Z$, or a combination of numerals and letters; and
(b) bear a nonremovable sticker denoting the correct county designation under 61-3-332.
(4) The department shall determine the minimum and maximum number of characters, including both numerals and letters, on the collegiate license plates.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Application for collegiate
license plates. An applicant for collegiate license plates or renewal of collegiate license plates pursuant to [section 5] shall apply in the form and by the date the department requires.

NEW SECTION. Section 5. Issuance -- application -additional fee -- disposition. (1) The department shall issue or renew collegiate license plates upon receipt of an application that shows:
(a) compliance with 61-3-303, 61-3-304, 61-3-311, and 61-3-312; and
(b) payment to the county treasurer of:
(i) an initial application and manufacturing fee of $\$ 2.50$, when required; and
(ii) an annual scholarship donation of $\mathbf{\$ 2 0}$ for the benefit of the institution named in the application.
(2) Once each month the county treasurer shall transfer to the state treasurer the total of the amounts collected for:
(a) the initial application and manufacturing fee for deposit in the Montana state prison industries account in the state special revenue fund for appropriation by the legislature to pay the cost of manufacturing collegiate license plates; and
(b) scholarship donations provided for in subsection (1)(b)(ii), along with a schedule showing the number of
collegiate license plates issued and the total donations received for the benefit of each institution.
(3) Once each month the state treasurer shall distribute to the student academic scholarship fund or foundation of each institution an amount equal to the total donations credited to that institution and transferred to the state treasurer by the county treasurers during the preceding month.

NEW SECTION. Section 6. Personalized collegiate license plates. (1) Subject to the provisions of 61-3-405 and 61-3-406, an application for collegiate licenst plates may be combined with an application for personalizes piates.
(2) An application for personalized collegiate license plates must be made on a form supplied by the department.
(3) Personalized collegiate license plates must bear the distinctive color and insignia as provided in [section $3]$.

NEW SECTION. Section 7. Authorization to receive and transmit donations. As provided in \{section 5\} and notwithstanding any other provisions of Title 7, Title 17, or this title:
(1) the county treasurer shall receive the annual scholarship donations provided for in [section 5] and once each month transmit those donations to the state treasurer; and
(2) the state treasurer shall accept the annual scholarship donations and once each month distribute the accumulated proceeds to the beneficiary institutions specified by and according to the totals contained in the county treasurers' reports.

Section 8. Section 61-3-403, MCA, is amended to read:

An act authorizing the issuance of collegiate license plates; authorizing the coliection of donations for academic scholarships in addition to regular license plate fees and the distribution of donations to higher education institutions; amending Section 61-3-403, MCA; and providing an applicability date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. $\quad 10,000$ sets of collegiate license plates will be issued in FY91.
2. The application and manufacturing fee per set will be $\$ 2.50$.
3. The annual scholarship donation will be $\$ 20$ for the benefit of the institution named in the application. 4. Purchasers of the collegiate license plates will be alumni, staff, and students of Montana's colleges and universities.
4. Applies to registrations of motor vehicles occurring after December 31, 1990.
