whereas, the Montana Medical Association has initiated a program known as MONT-SHARE under which physicians participating in the program agree to accept assignment as full payment for services performed for Medicare beneficiaries who do not have the ability to pay for the services: and

WHEREAS, in order for the MONT-SHARE program to be successful, all Montana physicians must agree to participate.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

(1) That Montana physicians be urged to participate in
