Procedure when hostage taken -- notice to public. (1) If a hostage is taken at the state prison, the 12 prison personnel shall immediately take all reasonable 13 14 action and use all reasonable force to regain control, restore order, and free the hostage. No person may negotiate 15 16 or bargain with the hostage-takers regarding the airing of 17 grievances or any other subject until the hostage has been 18 released, nor may any person negotiate or bargain for the 19 return of the hostage. 20 (2) The warden shall take all necessary steps to 21 ensure that each person entering the prison is informed of

the provisions of subsection (1). Each entrance to the prison, no matter who uses the entrance, must be posted with a prominent sign in legible print that quotes subsection (1) and states that a person entering the prison does so with

knowledge of the provisions of subsection (1). Each person
entering the prison must be shown the sign by prison
personnel.
