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22 23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. County retirement home. (1) For the purpose of creating housing for older persons, a county may develop, construct, and operate new housing or acquire, remodel, and operate existing housing as a county retirement home. A county may operate more than one retirement home within the county, but it may not operate more than a total of 50 retirement home sleeping rooms within the county.

- (2) (a) A county may establish tenant eligibility and preference requirements for a county retirement home. Except as provided in subsection (2)(b), tenant eligibility and preference requirements established by a county must comply with applicable federal and state laws and regulations governing nondiscrimination in housing.
- (b) Notwithstanding the provisions of 49-2-305,
 49-3-205, or any other provisions of state law, a county may
