16 Except as provided in 18-4-226(4), all proceeds received by

17 the department of administration from the sale of all

18 material, supplies, equipment, and all other personal

19 property of the department of highways shall be placed in

20 the highway account of the state special revenue fund or in

21 the appropriate enterprise or internal service fund
