"Stinger-steered automobile transporter" means a truck tractor-semitrailer combination that has a fifth wheel on a drop frame located behind and below the rear axle of the truck tractor and that is designed and used for the transportation of vehicles.

(c) All other combinations of vehicles may not have an overall length, inclusive of front and rear bumpers, in excess of 75 feet, except as provided by 61-10-124. If the combination consists of more than two units, the rear units of the combination shall be equipped with breakaway brakes.
