In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB082, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

SB082 would exempt the Montana Wheat and Barley Committee bureau chief from the state pay plan and from compensation increase limitations effective immediately.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Salary for the bureau chief would be established by the Wheat and Barley Committee at \$49,000 per year plus benefits of approximately \$10,000 per year.
- 2. Based on a survey of eleven other state, salaries of wheat commission administrators ranged from a low of \$42,132 to a high of \$65,000, with a median annual salary of \$45,000 and an average salary of \$49,367 when the high and low are excluded.
