Section 1. Section 2-15-1842, MCA, is amended to read: 9 10 "2-15-1842. Board of dentistry. (1) There is a board 11 of dentistry.

12 (2) (a) The board consists of four five dentists, one 13 denturist, one dental hygienist, and two public members, one 14 of whom must be a senior citizen. All members are appointed 15 by the governor with the consent of the senate. Each 16 licensed member shall be licensed to practice as a dentist, 17 denturist, or dental hygienist in this state, shall have 18 actively practiced in this state for at least 5 continuous 19 years immediately before his appointment, except as provided 20 in subsection (2)(b), and shall be actively engaged in 21 practice while serving on the board. Each member shall be a 22 resident of this state.

23 (b) The provision in subsection (2)(a) requiring a 24 licensed member to have actively practiced in this state for 25 at least 5 continuous years immediately before his



appointment does not apply to the first denturist appointed 1 to the board.

3 (3) Each member shall serve for a term of 5 years. The 4 governor may remove a member only for neglect or cause.

5 (4) The governor shall fill any vacancy within 30 6 days.

7 (5) The board is allocated to the department for 8 administrative purposes only as prescribed in 2-15-121."

9 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Extension of authority. Any 10 existing authority to make rules on the subject of the 11 provisions of {this act} is extended to the provisions of 12 [this act].
