In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB117, as introduced

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act to submit to the qualified electors of Montana an amendment to article IX, section 5, of the Montana Constitution to discontinue the deposit of coal severance tax collections in the coal severance tax trust fund.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This proposal will submit to the electors an amendment to the Constitution of Montana at the general election to be held in November 1990. A constitutional amendment approved by the electorate becomes effective on July 1st following the election. If approved this proposal would become effective on July 1, 1991, which is the start of FY92. There would be no impact on revenue during the current biennium.

If this constitutional amendment is approved, the 1991 Legislature would have the option to amend Section 15-35-108, MCA, to change the disposal of the coal severance tax. Currently this section allocates 50% of coal severance tax collections to the trust fund. For FY91 the coal severance tax is estimated to be \$45,683,000. Fifty percent of this revenue would be \$22,841,500.


