# STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

#### Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB119, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

This legislation would allow County Junk Vehicle programs to request additional annual funding for special vehicle collection programs such as river cleanups. Funds could also be used to provide additional vehicle collection after the county's annual grant is depleted.

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Assume County Junk Vehicle programs will request \$25,000 to \$30,000 additional funds per fiscal year. Historically, counties have only spent 85-90% of their annual grants. These remaining unspent funds could be used to fund special collection projects.
- 2. Assumed the re-registration fee increase legislation contained in HB111 to increase the Junk Vehicle License Registration Fee from \$.50 to \$1.10 will pass.
