10 **Section 1.** Section 45-9-107, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "45-9-107. Criminal possession of precursors to
12 dangerous drugs. (1) A person commits the offense of
13 criminal possession of precursors to dangerous drugs if he
14 possesses:

15 (a) phenyl-2-propanone (phenylacetone);

16 (b) both phenyl-2-propanone (phenylacetone) and
17 formamide or hydroxylamine at the same time with the intent
18 to manufacture amphetamine;

19 (c) both phenyl-2-propanone (phenylacetone) and
20 methylamine or N-methylformamide at the same time with the
21 intent to manufacture methamphetamine;

22 (d) both piperidine and cyclohexanone at the same
23 time, or a combination product thereof, with the intent to
24 manufacture phencyclidine (PCP).

25 (2) A person convicted of criminal possession of

1 precursors to dangerous drugs shall be imprisoned in the
2 state prison for a term not less than 2 years or more than
3 20 years or be fined an amount not to exceed \$50,000, or
4 both."



BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 45-9-107, MCA, is amended to read:

"45-9-107. Criminal possession of precursors to dangerous drugs. (1) A person commits the offense of criminal possession of precursors to dangerous drugs if he possesses:

(a) phenyl-2-propanone (phenylacetone);

(a)(b) both phenyl-2-propanone and phenylacetone; and formamide or hydroxylamine at the same time with the intent to manufacture amphetamine;

(b)(c) both phenyl-2-propanone and phenylacetone; and methylamine or N-methylformamide at the same time with the intent to manufacture OR methamphetamine, OR BOTH;

(c)(d)(B) both piperidine and cyclohexanone at the same time, or a combination product thereof, with the intent to manufacture phencyclidine (PCP).

(2) A person convicted of criminal possession of

precursors to dangerous drugs shall be imprisoned in the state prison for a term not less than 2 years or more than 20 years or be fined an amount not to exceed \$50,000, or both."
