A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TO INCREASE THE LENGTH OF TIME THE CLERK AND RECORDER HAS TO SUBMIT THE CLERK'S MONTHLY REPORT CONCERNING EXPENDITURES, LIABILITIES, AND APPROPRIATIONS TO THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS; AMENDING SECTION 7-6-2331, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Section 7-6-2331, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-6-2331. Clerk's report concerning expenditures, liabilities, and appropriations -- auditor's report. (1) On Within 15 working days following the first Monday in each month or upon receipt of the treasurer's monthly report, the county clerk and recorder shall submit to the board of county commissioners a report showing the expenditures and liabilities against each separate budget appropriation incurred during the preceding calendar month and like information for the whole of the fiscal year to the first day of the month in which such report is made, together with the unexpended balance of each appropriation. He shall also set forth the receipts from taxes and in detail the receipts from all other sources by each fund for the same period.

(2) In counties having county auditors, the county auditor, on the last business day of each month, shall furnish the county clerk and recorder with a statement showing the total amount of liabilities incurred against each budget appropriation for which warrants have not been issued up to the close of said business day."

NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Effective date. [This act] is effective on passage and approval.
