Section 1. Section 37-31-304, MCA, is amended to read:

"37-31-304. Qualifications of applicants for license to practice. (1) Before a person may practice cosmetology, he must obtain a license to practice cosmetology from the department. Before a person may practice manicuring, he must obtain a license to practice manicuring from the department unless he is licensed to practice cosmetology.

(2) (a) To be eligible to take the examination to practice cosmetology, the applicant must be not less than 18 years of age, ~~a graduate of the 8th grade,~~ and of good moral character and must possess a high school diploma or the equivalent of a high school diploma recognized by the superintendent of public instruction. The applicant must have completed a continuous course of study of at least 2,000 hours in a registered beauty school, which course of study has been distributed over a period of not less than 10

months or more than 14 months, and must have received a diploma from the beauty school or must have completed the course of study in cosmetology prescribed by the board of public-education.

(b) A person qualified under subsection (2)(a) shall file with the department a written application to take the examination and shall deposit with the department the required examination fee and pass an examination as to his fitness to practice cosmetology.

(3) (a) To be eligible to take the examination to practice manicuring, an applicant must be not less than 18 years of age, be of good moral character, possess a high school diploma, an equivalent of a high school diploma recognized by the superintendent of public instruction, or a certificate of completion from a vocational-technical center program, and have completed a course of study prescribed by the board in a registered school of cosmetology or a registered school of manicuring.

(b) A person qualified under subsection (3)(a) must file with the department a written application to take the examination and deposit with the department the required examination fee."


