10 Section 1. Section 81-7-401, MCA, is amended to read: 11 "81-7-401. Killing of dogs destroying or injuring 12 stock or poultry -- notice to owner. Any dog, whether 13 licensed or not, which, while off the premises owned or 14 under control of its owner, shall kill, wound, or injure any 15 livestock or poultry not belonging to the master of such the dog shall-be-deemed is considered to be a public nuisance 16 17 and may be killed forthwith by any person, or the owner, 18 when notified, shall kill such the dog within 24 hours, and if he fails to do so, an officer may be notified and shall 19 20 kill or cause the dog to be killed such--dog. Nothing 21 contained herein-shall-apply in this section applies to any 22 dog acting under the direction of its master or the agents 23 or employees of such its master."

Section 2. Section 81-7-403, MCA, is amended to read:
"81-7-403. Dogging livestock or poultry. Any person



1 who permits or directs any dog owned by him or in his 2 possession to chase or run any cattle, or other livestock. 3 or poultry of which he is not the owner or the person in 4 charge upon the open range or government lands or away from 5 any watering place upon the open range is guilty of a 6 misdemeanor and punishable by a fine of not more than \$50." -End-
