#### STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB237, as introduced.

## DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

SB237 would provide that a person issued a license or permit to hunt cow elk may take only a cow elk under that license.

## ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Assume there will be 20,000 cow elk permits and 1,000 A-7 cow elk licenses issued, consistent with the last license year.
- 2. All successful applicants for cow elk permits and licenses will be sent a nonremovable stamp to be placed on their A-5 elk license or their B-10 nonresident combination license to convert that license to a cow elk only license.
- 3. Dept. of Fish, Wildlife and Parks personnel will be sent a microfiche list of all holders of A-7 cow elk licenses and cow elk permits to assist them in enforcing the new regulations.
- 4. Implementation will begin with the March 1, 1990, license year.
