(1) The governing body of a 11 county may establish a road and bridge depreciation reserve 12 13 fund to be used for acquisition and replacement of property, 14 capital improvements, and equipment necessary to maintain 15 and improve county road and bridge facilities and services. 16 (2) County road and bridge money that has not been expended or encumbered for a fiscal year must be deposited 17 18 in the road and bridge depreciation reserve fund. County road and bridge money includes county road and bridge 19 appropriations; license and permit fees; federal, state, and 20 21 other revenues; and grants.

(3) Money in the road and bridge depreciation reserve
fund must be invested as provided by law. Interest and
income from the investment of the road and bridge
depreciation reserve fund must be credited to the fund.



## STATE OF MONTANA - FISCAL NOTE Form BD-15

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB256, as introduced.

# DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

SB256 would authorize creation of a county road and bridge depreciation reserve fund.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Creation of the depreciation reserve fund would be discretionary.
- 2. Once the reserve is created, however, all road and bridge fund cash at fiscal year-end would have to be transferred to the new fund.
- 3. There is no state fiscal impact.
- 4. Establishment of a capital improvement fund is currently authorized by Sections 7-6-2219 through 7-6-2221, MCA.

FISCAL IMPACT: None for state.

### TECHNICAL NOTES:

- 1. A depreciation reserve could cause budget problems for some counties if it were determined the cash in reserve were included in the 33 1/3% of budget requirement.
- 2. Questions may occur as to whether the Act would apply to the special voter-approved levies authorized in 7-14-2503 and 7-14-2504, MCA.
