BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 50-50-205, MCA, is amended to read:

"50-50-205. License fee —— late fee. (1) For each
license issued, the department shall collect a fee of \$30.

It shall deposit 85% of the fees collected in the state special revenue fund to the credit of the local board inspection fund account created by 50-2-108(2) and the balance of the fees in the state general fund.

(2) In addition to the license tee required under subsection (1), the department shall collect a late fee from any licensee who has failed to submit a license renewal fee

L	prior to the expiration of his current license and who

In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for \_SB323, as introduced.

#### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act entitled: "An act to require the Department of Health and Environmental Sciences to assess a late fee for delinquent license renewals for food establishments, hotels, motels, tourist homes, retirement homes, rooming houses; campgrounds, trailer courts, work camps, and youth camps; amending Sections 50-50-205, 50-51-204, and 50-52-202, MCA; providing a coordination instruction; and providing an effective date."

#### ASSUMPTIONS:

It is assumed that after appropriate early warning most of the current 1200-1700 late renewals would decline to approximately 180 during FY90. It is assumed that the number of delinquents would further decline during FY91 to about 75 and would remain at about that level into the future.

### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUE OR EXPENDITURES:

Local health authorities should be able to reduce their operational expenses devoted to assisting with the license delinquency program. No actual dollar value is available.

#### LONG-RANGE EFFECTS OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

If the late renewal fee results in the significant reduction in the number of late renewals, a corresponding reduction in the expenditures devoted to this problem should occur.
