estimate in each regular session and each special session in
which a revenue bill is under consideration. The committee

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1	shall issue periodic reports to the legislature in regular
2	session and in the interim between regular sessions,
3	indicating the committee's current revenue estimate.
4	(C) The committee's introduced version of the joint
5	resolution and subsequent periodic reports constitute the
6	legislature's current revenue estimate until final adoption
7	of the joint resolution by both houses.
8	(D) THE COMMITTEE MAY REQUEST THE ASSISTANCE OF THE
9	STAFFS OF THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL, THE OFFICE OF THE
10	LEGISLATIVE FISCAL ANALYST, THE LEGISLATIVE AUDITOR, THE
11	DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE, AND ANY OTHER AGENCY THAT HAS
12	INFORMATION REGARDING ANY OF THE TAX OR REVENUE BASES OF THE
13	STATE."
