4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING MOTOR HOMES
5 TO BE SUBJECT TO STAGGERED REGISTRATION; PROVIDING FOR
6 TRANSITIONAL AND NEW REGISTRATIONS OF MOTOR HOMES; AMENDING
7 SECTION 61-3-313, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN APPLICABILITY DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 61-3-313, MCA, is amended to read:

11 **"61-3-313. Vehicles subject to staggered registration.**

12 For purposes of 61-3-313 through 61-3-316 "vehicle" means
13 any motor vehicle as defined in 61-1-102 subject to annual
14 registration in this state except:

15 (1) vehicles owned or leased and operated by the
16 government of the United States, of the state of Montana, or
17 its political subdivisions;

18 (2) mobile homes ~~and-motor-homes~~;

19 (3) vehicles that are registered in accordance with or
20 subject to 61-3-411, 61-3-421, or 61-3-451;

21 (4) trucks exceeding a licensed gross vehicle weight
22 of 10,000 pounds;

23 (5) trailers, semitrailers, tractors, buses,
24 motorcycles, quadricycles, and motor-driven cycles;

25 (6) special mobile equipment as defined in 61-1-104."

1 **NEW SECTION. Section 2. Transitional and new**
2 **registrations.** Each motor home currently registered in
3 Montana and subject to the provisions of [this act] must be
4 reregistered under the provisions of [this act] and must be
5 assigned a registration period under 61-3-314 that
6 corresponds to the last digit on the license plate issued to
7 that motor home in 1989. Motor homes that are registered
8 for the first time in Montana must be assigned a
9 registration period corresponding to the month when they are
10 first registered in this state. The registration period
11 thereafter remains the same from year to year.

12 **NEW SECTION. Section 3. Applicability.** [This act]
13 applies to registrations of motor homes occurring after
14 December 31, 1989.

15 **NEW SECTION. Section 4. Extension of authority.** Any
16 existing authority to make rules on the subject of the
17 provisions of [this act] is extended to the provisions of
18 [this act].
