DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act revising provisions concerning the purchase of creditable service for out-of-state employment and for employment while on leave under the Teachers' Retirement System; amending Sections 19-4-402 and 19-4-403, MCA; and providing an effective date.

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. Members of the Teachers' Retirement System eligible to purchase additional service under the provisions of this bill will be required to pay the current cost as provided for purchasing additional service. The number of members affected by this proposal is unknown.
- 2. Administration of this proposal by the Teachers' Retirement System will not require additional FTE's.
- 3. Members retired under the TRS prior to the effective date of the legislation will be ineligible to qualify additional service under this proposal.
