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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

\*85-1-203. State water plan. (1) The department shall gather from any source reliable information relating to Montana's water resources and prepare therefrom from the information a continuing comprehensive inventory of the water resources of the state. In preparing this inventory, the department may conduct studies; adopt studies made by other competent water resource groups, including federal, regional, state, or private agencies; perform research or employ other competent agencies to perform research on a contract basis; and hold public hearings in affected areas at which all interested parties shall must be given an opportunity to appear.

(2) The department shall formulate and, with the approval of the board, adopt and from-time-to-time amend, extend, or add to a comprehensive, coordinated multiple-use

water resources plan known as the "state water plan". The state water plan may be formulated and adopted in sections. 3 these sections corresponding with hydrologic divisions of the state. The state water plan shall must set out a progressive program for the conservation, development, and utilization of the state's water resources and propose the 7 most effective means by which these water resources may be 8 applied for the benefit of the people, 9 consideration of alternative uses and combinations of uses. 10 Before adoption-of adopting the state water plan or any section thereof of the plan, the department shall hold 11 12 public hearings in the state or in an area of the state 13 encompassed by a section thereof of the plan if adoption of 14 a section is proposed.
