A corporation or a partnership may act as a real-estate-broker licensee if every corporate officer and every partner performing the functions of a "broker", -as-defined-in-37-51-102, licensee is licensed as-a-broker under this chapter. All officers of a corporation or all members of a partnership acting as a broker licensee are in violation of this chapter unless
