If the number of trustee positions in a third-class elementary district is decreased from five to three in accordance with the provisions of 20-3-341, one position is eliminated at the time of the first subsequent school election when two trustee positions would have been filled and one position is eliminated at the next school election when two trustee positions would have been filled.
