8	AS THE "YELLOWSTONE RIVER SCENIC ROUTE".
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10	WHEREAS, State Highway No. 10 was the main route
11	through Stillwater County along the Yellowstone River; and
12	WHEREAS, the construction of Interstate 90 caused a
13	reduction in traffic on this route and deprived tourists of
14	the amenities offered along State Highway No. 10; and
15	WHEREAS, the designation of State Highway No. 10 as the
16	"Yellowstone River Scenic Route" would be an alternative to
17	interstate travel for vacation travelers; and
18	WHEREAS, a scenic route designation of State Highway
19	No. 10 will help the travel industry in the communities
20	along this route.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE

to designate State Highway No. 10 from the Park City

That the Legislature request the Department of Highways

OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Interchange to the Springtime Interchange 1 "Yellowstone River Scenic Route". 2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Department of Highways 3 be requested to install the necessary signing to identify State Highway No. 10 as the "Yellowstone River Scenic Route" 5 at all appropriate locations accessing the route and along the route, and that the Department provide interpretative signing at turnout locations near Benson's Bluff west of Columbus and near Countryman Bluff east of Columbus.

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
