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BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 20-9-344, MCA, is amended to read:

"20-9-344. Purpose of state equalization aid and
duties of the board of public education for distribution -conditions of first payment. (1) The money available for
state equalization aid shall must be distributed and
apportioned to provide an annual minimum operating revenue

16 for:

DELAYED EFFECTIVE DATE."

(a) the elementary and high schools in each county, exclusive of revenues required for debt service; and

- (b) for the payment of any and-all costs and expense expenses incurred in connection with any adult education program, recreation program, school food services program, new buildings_new and grounds, and transportation.
- (2) The board of public education shall administer and distribute the state equalization aid in the manner and with the powers and duties provided by law. To this end, the

board of public education shall:

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2 (a) adopt policies for regulating the distribution of
3 state equalization aid in accordance with the provisions of
4 law and in a manner that would-most-effectively-meet-the
5 financial--needs---of---districts provides for monthly
6 distribution to each district of its equalization aid
7 entitlement;

- (b) have the power to require such reports from the county superintendents, budget boards, county treasurers, and trustees as it may-deem considers necessary; and
 - (c) order the superintendent of public instruction to distribute the state equalization aid on the basis of each district's annual entitlement to such the aid as established by the superintendent of public instruction. In ordering the distribution of state equalization aid, the board of public education shall may not increase or decrease the state equalization aid distribution to any district on account of any difference which that may occur during the school fiscal year between budgeted and actual receipts from any other source of school revenue.
- (3) Should If a district receive receives more state equalization aid than it is entitled to, the county treasurer must shall return the overpayment to the state upon the request of the superintendent of public instruction in the manner prescribed by the department of commerce.
