House BILL NO. 40 1 INTRODUCED BY 2 nonvoting member. 3 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT CREATING A LEGISLATIVE 4 OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE ON SCHOOL FUNDING IMPLEMENTATION; 5 APPROPRIATING FUNDS FOR THE COMMITTEE'S USE; AND PROVIDING 6 AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE." 7 R BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA: 9 NEW SECTION. Section 1. Definition. As used in (this 10 act], "committee" means the legislative oversight committee 11 on school funding implementation created in [section 2]. 12 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Legislative oversight 13 committee on school funding implementation -- composition 14 and appointment. (1) There is a legislative oversight 15 committee on school funding implementation. 16 (2) The committee consists of 11 members, including: 17 business. (a) four members of the house of representatives 18 appointed by the speaker of the house; 19 as provided in 5-2-302. (b) four members of the senate appointed by the 20 committee on committees of the senate; 21 (c) the superintendent of public instruction or his 22 designee as an ex officio nonvoting member; 23 equalization, including: (d) a member of the board of public education as an ex 24 officio nonvoting member; and 25

(f) the governor or his designee as an ex officio

(3) No more than two legislative members from each house may be of the same political party. Legislative members must be appointed no later than July 14, 1989.

NEW SECTION. Section 3. Term of office -- vacancies. (1) A committee member shall serve until the committee terminates as provided in [section 7].

(2) A vacancy on the committee must be filled in the same manner as the original appointment.

NEW SECTION. Section 4. Officers -- meetings

quorum -- compensation. (1) The committee shall choose from

its membership a chairman and vice chairman.

(2) The committee shall meet upon the call of the chairman or at the request of any five members.

(3) Six members constitute a quorum to transact

(4) A legislative member is entitled to compensation

NEW SECTION. Section 5. Duties of the committee. The duties of the committee include but are not limited to;

(1) monitoring the implementation of school funding

(a) identification of any problems in implementation and of options for resolving these problems;

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(b) continued analysis of school district budget and
 expenditure data and of improvements in school district
 accounting and reporting procedures; and

6 (2) directing the following studies of issues related7 to school funding equalization:

8 (a) school transportation equalization, including but9 not limited to:

10 (i) mechanisms to equalize transportation funding; and 11 (ii) analysis of issues related to the costs and 12 efficiencies of school transportation, including reimbursement schedules, load requirements, 3-mile limit, 13 transporting ineligible transportees, functions of the 14 county transportation committee, and school district 15 16 reporting and budgeting duties;

17 (b) school district capital outlay and debt service18 equalization, including but not limited to:

(i) analysis of school district funds and budgets for
various school district capital outlay and debt service
obligations;

22 (ii) options for equalizing school district capital23 outlay and debt service obligations; and

(c) continued study of issues related to equalization,including but not limited to comprehensive insurance,

uncollected taxes, tuition, student-based funding
 distribution methods, special education funding, and federal
 Public Law 81-874 revenue, especially as it pertains to
 revenue not linked to Native American students;

5 (3) ongoing analysis of revenue sources related to6 school funding;

7 (4) holding discussions with any party contemplating 8 litigation regarding compliance with the rulings by the 9 supreme court and district court on school funding 10 equalization; and

11 (5) reporting its findings, options for legislative 12 consideration, and any proposed legislation to the governor 13 and the 52nd legislature.

<u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 6. Staff assistance. The
 committee may request the following governmental entities to
 provide staff assistance to the committee:

17 (1) the office of public instruction;

18 (2) the governor's office of budget and program 19 planning;

- 20 (3) the board of public education;
- 21 (4) the legislative council;
- 22 (5) the office of the legislative fiscal analyst; and
- 23 (6) the office of the legislative auditor.

24 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 7. Termination. [This act]

25 terminates December 31, 1990.
