A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: nAN ACT TO INCREASE BY 2 PERCENT TEE MAXIMUM GENERAL FUND BUDGET SCHEDULES FOR ELEMENTARY SCHOOLS AND HIGH SCHOOLS FOR SCHOOL FISCAL YEAR 1989-90; TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO THE SUPERINTENDENT OF PUBLIC INSTRUCTION FOR STATE EQUALIZATION AID; AMENDING SECTIONS 20-9-316 AND 20-9-317, HCA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
Section 1. Section 20-9-316, MCA, is amended to read:
"20-9-316. Elementary school maximum budget schedule for t985-86 1989-90. (1) For each elementary school having an ANB of nine or fewer pupils, the maximum shatz-be-\$19.959 is \(\$ 20,562\) if said the school is approved as an isolated school.
(2) For schools with an ANB of 10 pupils but less than 18 pupils, the maximum shati--be--\$797959 is \(\$ 20,562\) plus \(\$ 834- \pm \theta\) \$859.30 per pupil on the basis of the average number belonging over nine.
(3) For schools with an ANB of at least 14 pupils but less than 18 pupils that qualify for instructional aide
funding under 20-9-322, the maximum shati-be-\$3277i4 is \(\$ 33,702\) plus \(\$ 834=7 \theta\) \$859.30 per pupil on the basis of the average number belonging over 14.
(4) For schools with an ANB of 18 pupils and employing one teacher, the maximum shatz-be-\$27-466 is \(\$ 28,295\) plus \(\$ 834 \div 7 \theta\) \$859.30 per pupil on the basis of the average number belonging over 18, not to exceed an ANB of 25.
(5) For schools with an ANB of 18 pupils and employing two full-time teachers, the maximum shałt--be--\$43-85ı is \(\$ 45.176\) plus \(\$ 57 z=4 \theta\) \$538.10 per pupil on the basis of the average number belonging over iB, not to exceed an ans of 50.
(6) For schools having an ANB in excess of 40 , the maximum, on the basis of the total pupils (ANB) in the district for-etementary-pupits-wizt-be, is as follows:
(a) For a school having an ANB of more than 40 and employing a minimum of three teachers, the maximum of \$ł-93日 shazt-be \(\$ 1,996\) is decreased at the rate of \(\$ \pm=80 \$ 1.94\) for each additional pupil until the total number (ANB) shat have-reached-a-totaz-of reaches 100 pupils.
(b) For a school having an ans of more than 100 pupils, the maximum of \(\$ \ddagger 825-s h a \neq t-b e \$ 1,880\) is decreased at the rate of \(\$ \pm 7 \boldsymbol{7 x} \$ 1.77\) for each additional pupil until the ANB shati-have-reached reaches 300 pupils.
(c) For a school having an ANB of more than 300

(3) For a school having an ANB of more than 40 pupils, the maximum of \(\$ 47 \boldsymbol{3 Z 4}\)-shati \(\$ 4,455\) be is decreased at the rate of \(\$ 25=84 \$ 26.62\) for each additional pupil until the ANB shazt-have-reaehed reaches 100 pupils.
(4) For a school having an ANB of more than 100 pupils, a the maximum of \(\$ 27774-5\) nati \(\$ 2,858\) be is decreased
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at the rate of \$4:3z \$4.45 for each additional pupil until
the ANB shamz-have-reached reaches 200 pupils.
(5) For a school having an ANB of more than 200 pupils, the maximum of $\$ 2 ; 34 z-s h a \ddagger \pm \$ 2,412$ be is decreased by $\$ z=38 \$ 2.45$ for each additional pupil until the ANB shequ have-reached reaches 300 pupils.
(6) For a school having an ANB of more than 300 pupils, the maximum of $\$ 27 \pm \theta 4-s h a t z \$ 2,168$ be is decreased at the rate of 4445 cents for each additional pupil until the ANB shatz-have-reached reaches 600 pupils.
(7) For a school having an ANB over of more than 600 pupils, the maximum shaz may not exceed $\$ 7,973 \$ 2,032$ per pupil.
(8) The maximum per pupil for all pupils (ANB) and for all high schools shat must be computed on the basis of the amount allowed herein in this section on account of the last eligible pupil (ANB). All high schools and junior high schools which have been approved and accredited as junior high schools, operated within the incorporated limits of a city or town, shatz must be treated as one school for the purpose of this schedule."
