A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT ALLOWING A 12TH GRADE
PUPIL TO BE REIMBURSED FOR THE COST OF ATTENDING A COURSE AT

INSTITUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND A
TERMINATION DATE."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

NEW SECTION. Section 1. Tuition reimbursement for twelfth grade pupils taking courses at another school --publication of courses and tuition -- credit. (1) Subject to available appropriated funds, the superintendent of public instruction shall reimburse a 12th grade pupil who completes a course at a Montana high school other than the one in which he is enrolled or at an accredited postsecondary educational institution in Montana. A pupil may not be reimbursed in any one year for the cost of more than 10 hours of class a week times the number of weeks in the school year. A pupil may be reimbursed for any number of courses, but the total course hours for which he is reimbursed may not exceed this reimbursement limit.

(2) Each public high school and postsecondary



educational institution that offers courses to 12th grade
pupils from other schools shall on or before July 15 of each
year publish a list of the courses offered and state the
tuition for each course.

[3] A pupil who successfully completes a course at a

public postsecondary educational institution must be given credit for the course at both his high school and the postsecondary educational institution.

9 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> **Section 2.** Effective date --10 termination. (1) [This act] is effective July 1, 1989.

11 (2) [This act] terminates June 30, 1991.
