BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

Section 1. Section 7-4-102, MCA, is amended to read:

"7-4-102. Office hours. (1) Unless otherwise provided by law, every officer ~~must~~ shall keep his office open for the transaction of business continuously from 8 a.m. until 5 p.m. each day except Saturdays and legal holidays. Every officer shall keep his office open at such other times as the accommodation of the public or the proper transaction of business requires, ~~except county.~~

(2) County and city treasurers, ~~---who---in---their~~ discretion may, in the interest of the safekeeping of funds, securities, and records under their control, close their offices during the period from noon to 1 p.m. every day.

(3) The governing body of a third-class city or town may establish days and times when municipal offices are open to conduct business that are different from the days and times required by subsection (1)."


In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for SB17, as introduced.


FISCAL IMPACT:
