4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TRANSFERRING TO THE
5 GENERAL FUND \$250,000 FROM THE CRIME VICTIMS COMPENSATION
6 ACCOUNT; AMENDING SECTION 53-9-109, MCA; AND PROVIDING AN
7 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND A TERMINATION DATE."

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

10 **Section 1.** Section 53-9-109, MCA, is amended to read:

11 "53-9-109. Crime victims compensation account. (1)
12 There is a crime victims compensation and assistance account
13 in the state special revenue fund. There shall be paid into
14 this account 18% of the fines assessed and bails forfeited,
15 except those paid to a justice's court, on all offenses
16 involving a violation of chapter 3, part 1 of chapter 4, or
17 chapters 5 through 10 of Title 61 that are a result of
18 citations or tickets issued by the highway patrol. ~~The~~
19 Except as provided in subsection (2), the money in the
20 account is to be used solely for the purposes of this part
21 and for victims' assistance program coordination and
22 planning provided by the division. ~~No~~ Except as provided in
23 subsection (2), no fund balance in the account at the end of
24 a fiscal year may be deposited in the general fund.

25 (2) On or before June 30, 1992, the division shall

1 transfer \$250,000 from the crime victims compensation and
2 assistance account to the general fund."

3 NEW SECTION. Section 2. Effective date -- termination.
4 [This act] is effective on passage and approval and
5 terminates July 1, 1992.


In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0021, as introduced.
