4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT REQUIRING CERTAIN STATE
5 AND LOCAL GOVERNMENT EMPLOYEE LEAVES OF ABSENCE FOR MILITARY
6 TRAINING TO BE WITHOUT PAY; AMENDING SECTION 10-1-604, MCA;
7 AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND AN
8 APPLICABILITY DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 **Section 1.** Section 10-1-604, MCA, is amended to read:

12 "10-1-604. Leave of absence of public employees
13 attending training camp or similar training program. A
14 state, city, town, or county employee who is a member of the
15 organized militia of this state or who is a member of the
16 organized or unorganized reserve corps or military forces of
17 the United States and who has been an employee for a period
18 of 6 months shall be given leave of absence with without pay
19 for a period of time not to exceed 15 working days in a
20 calendar year for attending regular encampments, training
21 cruises, and similar training programs of the organized
22 militia or of the military forces of the United States. This
23 ~~leave--may--not--be--charged--against--the--employee's--annual~~
24 ~~vacation-time-~~"

25 NEW SECTION. **Section 2.** Effective date --

1 applicability. [This act] is effective on passage and
2 approval and applies to leaves of absence authorized after
3 [the effective date of this act].
