DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:


An act temporarily prohibiting the printing and distribution of unsolicited copies of state agency newsletters wholly or partially paid for with state funds; and providing an immediate effective date.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

16 NEW SECTION. **Section 1.** Temporary prohibition on
17 printing and distributing unsolicited copies of agency
18 newsletters. Between [the effective date of this act] and
19 ~~April 30, 1993~~ DECEMBER 31, 1992, an agency, as defined in
20 2-18-101, may not print and distribute unsolicited copies of
21 periodically published newsletters or similar publications
22 that are wholly or partially paid for with state funds and
23 that contain news relating to the employees and operations
24 of the agency.
