BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

**Section 1.** Article IX, section 5, of The Constitution of the State of Montana is amended to read:

"Section 5. Severance tax on coal — trust fund — school finance. The legislature shall dedicate not less than one-fourth (1/4) of the coal severance tax to school finance and not less than one-fourth (1/4) of the coal severance tax to a trust fund,—the. The interest and income from which the trust may be appropriated. The principal of the trust shall forever remain inviolate unless appropriated by vote of three-fourths (3/4) of the members of each house of the legislature. After-December-317-1979,—at-least-fifty-percent t50%)—of-the-severance-tax-shall-be-dedicated-to—the--trust
