4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT TRANSFERRING \$300,000  
5 IN REVENUE UNRELATED TO PER CAPITA LEVY REVENUE FROM THE  
6 INSPECTION AND CONTROL ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL FUND;  
7 TRANSFERRING \$300,000 IN REVENUE UNRELATED TO PER CAPITA  
8 LEVY REVENUE FROM THE ANIMAL HEALTH ACCOUNT TO THE GENERAL  
9 FUND; AND PROVIDING AN IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE AND A  
10 TERMINATION DATE."

12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

13        NEW SECTION.    **Section 1.**    Transfer of revenue to general  
14 fund. (1) On or before September 1, 1992, the department of  
15 livestock shall transfer \$300,000 in revenue that is  
16 unrelated to per capita levy revenue from the inspection and  
17 control account to the general fund.

18        (2) On or before September 1, 1992, the department of  
19 livestock shall transfer \$300,000 in revenue that is  
20 unrelated to per capita levy revenue from the animal health  
21 account to the general fund.

22        NEW SECTION.    **Section 2.**    Effective date -- termination.  
23 [This act] is effective on passage and approval and  
24 terminates September 2, 1992.


In compliance with a written request, there is hereby submitted a Fiscal Note for HB0042, as introduced.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act transferring \$300,000 in revenue unrelated to per capita levy revenue from the inspection and control account to the general fund; transferring \$300,000 in revenue unrelated to per capita levy revenue from the animal health account to the general fund; and providing an immediate effective date and a termination date.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed legislation would transfer \$600,000 to the general fund in fiscal year 1993.
