4 A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT PROHIBITING THE
5 IMPORTATION OF HAZARDOUS WASTE OR HAZARDOUS WASTE-DERIVED
6 FUEL INTO MONTANA FOR DISPOSAL OR INCINERATION OR FOR USE AS
7 A SUPPLEMENTAL FUEL UNTIL OCTOBER 1, 1993; AND PROVIDING AN
8 IMMEDIATE EFFECTIVE DATE."

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

11 NEW SECTION. **Section 1. Moratorium** on certain
12 interstate transport of hazardous waste or hazardous
13 waste-derived fuel. (1) The state of Montana recognizes the
14 importance of providing for disposal or incineration of
15 hazardous waste or for the use of hazardous waste-derived
16 fuel in a manner that protects Montana's public health,
17 safety, welfare, and environment. Although the state of
18 Montana recognizes that, under appropriate conditions, the
19 transportation of out-of-state hazardous waste or hazardous
20 waste-derived fuel into Montana may not conflict with this
21 goal, it is imperative that the state further develop
22 regional and statewide hazardous waste management goals,
23 plans, and regulations and revise its rules governing
24 hazardous waste facility siting and operation criteria
25 before allowing hazardous waste or hazardous waste-derived

1 fuel importation.
2 (2) Until October 1, 1993, a person may not transport
3 hazardous waste or hazardous waste-derived fuels into
4 Montana for disposal or incineration or for use as
5 supplemental fuel.

6 NEW SECTION. **Section 2. Codification instruction.**
7 [Section 1] is intended to be codified as an integral part
8 of Title 75, chapter 10, part 4, and the provisions of Title
9 75, chapter 10, part 4, apply to [section 1].

10 NEW SECTION. **Section 3. Effective date.** [This act] is
11 effective on passage and approval.
