13 WHEREAS, the Department of Corrections and Human 14 Services has proposed to close the acute care hospital and 15 intermediate nursing care program on the Galen campus of the 16 Montana State Hospital; and

WHEREAS, the Galen facility is being underused, has
increasing operating costs, and has a decaying and
inefficient infrastructure; and

20 WHEREAS, there is more appropriate and improved care 21 available to the patients of the Galen acute care hospital 22 and intermediate care nursing facility at other state and 23 private institutions.

25 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
