A forward estimate appropriation must be accounted and reported separately from all other appropriations.
- (3) Agencies may transfer forward estimate appropriations among fund types, other than the general fund, in accordance with 17 2 102 when justified to do so and when approved by the approving authority. General fund appropriations are not included.
- (4) Agencies may transfer forward estimate appropriations between fiscal years within the biennium.
- (5) In the event that an agency's contracts exceed its forward estimate appropriation during the biennium, additional spending authority must be established in accordance with the provisions of the budget amendment law in Title 17, chapter 7, part 4.
