### DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act extending longevity payments to all employees of sheriff's departments.

### ASSUMPTIONS:

1. There is no appreciable state fiscal impact.

FISCAL IMPACT: Insignificant.

#### EFFECT ON COUNTY OR OTHER LOCAL REVENUES OR EXPENDITURES:

There will be a moderate local impact from extending longevity payments to jailers, secretaries and dispatchers. For example, in Lewis and Clark County, the 1% longevity payment for sheriff department employees, other than deputies and undersheriffs, would be approximately \$12,000 per year.
