2	INTRODUCED BY DAILY
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4	A BILL FOR AN ACT ENTITLED: "AN ACT SUBMITTING TO THE
5	QUALIFIED ELECTORS OF MONTANA AN AMENDMENT TO ARTICLE X,
6	SECTION 9, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF MONTANA TO
7	INCREASE THE NUMBER OF THE MEMBERS OF THE BOARD OF REGENTS
8	FROM SEVEN TO NINE AND TO CHANGE THE MANNER OF SELECTION OF
9	THE MEMBERS."

11	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:
12	Section 1. Article X, section 9, of The Constitution of
13	the State of Montana is amended to read:

14 "Section 9. Boards of education. (1) There is a state 15 board of education composed of the board of regents of higher education and the board of public education. It is 16 17 responsible for long-range planning, and for coordinating and evaluating policies and programs for the state's 18 educational systems. It shall submit unified budget 19 requests. A tie vote at any meeting may be broken by the 20 governor, who is an ex officio member of each component 21 22 board.

(2) (a) The government and control of the Montana 23 university system is vested in a board of regents of higher 24 education which shall have full power, responsibility, and 25

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1 authority to supervise, coordinate, manage and control the 2 Montana university system and shall supervise and coordinate other public educational institutions assigned by law. 3

4 (b) The board consists of seven nine members. Three 5 members, one of whom shall be a student of the university 6 system, shall be appointed by the governor, and confirmed by 7 the senater-to-overlapping-termsr-as-provided--by--law. The 8 caucus of the majority and minority party in each house of 9 the legislature shall each select a member. Each house of 10 the legislature shall select a member by majority vote. If 11 there is a tie vote, the candidate of the political party 12 that has a member of that party as the governor of Montana 13 is selected. The members shall serve overlapping two-year 14 terms, as provided by law, and may be reappointed. The 15 governor and superintendent of public instruction are ex officio non-voting members of the board. The members shall 16 17 select a presiding officer by majority vote. Legislators 18 appointed to the board are not subject to Article V, section 9, and their service does not violate Article III, section 19 20 1. 21 (c) The board shall appoint a commissioner of higher

education and prescribe his term and duties. 23 (d) The funds and appropriations under the control of 24 the board of regents are subject to the same audit 25 provisions as are all other state funds.

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1 (3) (a) There is a board of public education to 2 exercise general supervision over the public school system 3 and such other public educational institutions as may be 4 assigned by law. Other duties of the board shall be provided 5 by law.

6 (b) The board consists of seven members appointed by 7 the governor, and confirmed by the senate, to overlapping 8 terms as provided by law. The governor, commissioner of 9 higher education and state superintendent of public 10 instruction shall be ex officio non-voting members of the 11 board."

12 <u>NEW SECTION.</u> Section 2. Submission to electorate. This 13 amendment shall be submitted to the qualified electors of 14 Montana at the first statewide election held after passage 15 of this act by the legislature by printing on the ballot the 16 full title of this act and the following:

18 the members of the board of regents.

AGAINST changing the number and manner of selection of the members of the board of regents.
