Section 15-24-921, MCA, is amended to read: 9 \*15-24-921. Per capita tax levy to pay expenses of 10 enforcing livestock laws. (1) In addition to appropriations 11 for such purposes, a per capita tax is hereby 12 made authorized and directed to be levied by the county assessor 13 on all poultry and bees, all swine 3 months of age or older, 14 and all other livestock 9 months of age or older in each 15 county of this state for the purpose of aiding in the 16 payment of the salaries and all expenses connected with the 17 enforcement of the livestock laws of the state and for the 18 payment of bounties on wild animals as hereinafter 19 20 specified.

(2) As used in this section, "livestock" means cattle,
sheep, swine, poultry, bees, goats, horses, mules, asses,
llamas as defined in B1-1-101, domestic bison, and domestic
ungulates."
