11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF MONTANA:

12 **Section 1.** Section 7-8-4201, MCA, is amended to read:

13 "7-8-4201. Disposal or lease of municipal property. (1)

14 Subject to the provisions of subsection (2), the city or
15 town council may sell, dispose of, or lease any property
16 belonging to the city or town.

17 (2) (a) ~~Such~~ The lease or transfer ~~shall~~ must be made
18 by an ordinance or resolution passed by a two-thirds vote of
19 all the members of the council.

20 (b) ~~If~~ Except for property acquired by tax deed, if the
21 property is held in trust for a specific purpose, the sale
22 or lease thereof must be approved by a majority vote of the
23 electors of the municipality voting at an election called
24 for that purpose.

25 (3) ~~Nothing--contained--herein~~ This section may not be

1 construed to abrogate the power of the board of park
2 commissioners to lease all lands owned by the city
3 heretofore that were acquired for parks within the
4 limitations prescribed by 7-16-4223."
