<u>DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION</u>: An act abolishing the requirement that the Department of Justice compile, publish, and biennially update fire protection laws, distribute them to sheriffs and fire departments, and make them available to the public.

ASSUMPTIONS:

1. The cost of printing and mailing the fire code updates is \$3,000 in the first year of each biennium. This amount of general fund expenditures will be reduced in FY94 under this bill.
