DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSED LEGISLATION:

An act revising the definition of "Special Mobile Equipment"; excluding farm tractors and concrete mixers from the definition of "Special Mobile Equipment".

ASSUMPTIONS:

- 1. This bill may cause some vehicles currently licensed as "special mobile equipment" to be licensed as trucks and trailers.
- 2. Special mobile equipment is assessed the same fees as trucks and trailers with the exception that special mobile equipment is exempt from Gross Vehicle Weight (GVW) fees.

FISCAL IMPACT:

This bill will have a slight positive impact on revenue; however, there is no basis from which to project the additional revenue that would be collected.
